Philippians 3:10

02/ **Spirit of
restraint**

Proverbs 25:28

The Bible warns us that if we do not have self-control, we will become slaves to what controls us. Pray that your child will grow in self-control and discipline.

03/ **Hatred of sin
and love for
righteousness**

Amos 5:15

Pray that your child will understand what is good and what is evil. Pray that they draw clear lines of right and wrong in their lives and boldly declare evil as evil and good as good.

04/ **Wisdom**

James 1:5

Pray that your child will grow in wisdom and knowledge. Pray that God would grant them a spirit of wisdom that supersedes their experience and age.

05/ **Shield of
protection**

Psalms 3:3

Pray that God will cover your child with His blood and put a fence of protection around them. Pray He keeps them from anyone who would seek to cause them harm mentally, spiritually, emotionally or physically.

06/ **Godly friends
and influences**

Proverbs 18:24

Pray that your child will develop friendships with those who stand with them in their convictions. Pray they are kept from ungodly influences.

07/ **Submit to God
and resist Satan**

James 4:7

Pray your child would develop the courage and boldness to resist temptation and the ability and humility to submit their lives and future to God.

08/ **Purity**

Psalms 24:4

Pray your child will be kept pure in mind, spirit and deed.

09/ **Respect for
authority**

Romans 13:1

Pray that your child will develop a healthy understanding of the role of authority in their lives. Pray, as you continue to teach them, that they will grow in the knowledge of the beauty submission brings to their lives.

when guilty**

James 1:15
